

Avon Township Groundbreaking Ceremony

On an overcast Saturday morning in late May, the Avon Township Board, accompanied by family, members of the Township Building Committee, architect Dan Tideman, representatives from the construction management company RA Morton, and site contractors, celebrated the off the official groundbreaking of the Avon Township Hall and Equipment Storage Building. The complex is located at 16881 Queens Road, Avon Minnesota and is scheduled for completion Fall 2010. Township residents voted to begin this project at a special meeting held October 2009. The township needs the facility to begin plowing its own snow, have a space for storage of township records, and ultimately for voting. The Township will continue to vote at the Avon Catholic Church through this year, but will vote at the new facility beginning in 2011.
