Fire Board Meeting Minutes

Motion by Guggenberger to approve the minutes of the February 2014 meeting.

Second by Merdan

Motion-Passed-Unanimously-

Avon Fire Relief Association: Corey Nellis reviewed the Relief Association fund report. The fund currently has and is projected to have a healthy level of surplus funds which will help with upcoming payouts for retiring members. It is a goal to increase the Relief Association contribution by \$200 from \$1,800 to \$2,000 per year in 2016. The commitment and role of the fire department members has grown dramatically in the past few years. The number of calls has increased substantially. They are now at 23 members and want to get up to 25 in the near future. They have several-good-applicants-including a female-prospect-for-the-first-time.

Fire Contract: Members briefly reviewed the Fire Department Contract. Bob Simon again expressed a desire to move toward a Joint Powers Agreement or some language in the contract format that allows the Townships to have some input into capital asset purchases. He suggested language spelling out a cap on the Townships' financial involvement over a certain dollar threshold for big trucks/equipment and a new fire hall. The numbers he recommended would be up to \$750,000 for a new fire hall building and \$375,000 for a new truck. The Townships would like to see the large asset purchases follow a process that is inclusionary. Members discussed the cost of various types of buildings. Members then discussed a concept where the Fire Board or a committee could be formed to be responsible to review and recommend approval of purchases of large asset items. It was a consensus that it is worth more discussion in the future.

Projects and Purchases: Gary Schmitz reviewed the minimal projects and purchases in 2014. Pump repairs and new pagers totaled \$7,374.70. The FEMA grant application due in April will request \$152,500. Replacing turn-out gear is a goal. The turn-out gear can still be used a few more years if AFD does not get awarded this funding. Building repair issues that arose during the past year included a roof leak and a need for a new furnace which was just recently newly installed. It was noted that some of the tools and machinery the Department uses is at least 10 years old now. Getting a washer and dryer at the Fire Hall continues to be a goal.

The recently purchased "brush rig" was reviewed. It is a 1-ton Dodge pickup; not a crew cab. The purchase price was \$27,143.75. Equipment add-ons cost \$5,230.86 with some other additional work bringing the cost to \$35,000 +/-.

<u>Membership:</u> Department membership is currently at 23. Two members have 20 plus years. The goal is to bring on several new members and train them together to bring membership to 25. A new wireless call response application for cell phones and computers was briefly discussed.

Fundraisers: The amount from the calendar sales brought in about \$5,000. The Blattner Golf Tournament raised \$18,000. The Department will hold a Spunk Days raffle again as well. Members work hard to carry them out.

Billing for Fire Calls: Billing/collection of fire calls was briefly reviewed by Gary.

### 2014 Calls and Financial Report\*\* Gary Schmitz reviewed the report

There were 174 total calls totaling 2,368 hours.

Avon City = 44 calls (531 hours)

Collegeville Twp. = 35 calls (383 hours)

Avon Twp. = 67 calls (874 hours)

J=94 = 22 calls (295 hours)

Mutual Aid = 6 (285 hours)

Combined cost for fire and emergency call response during the 2014 calendar year was \$98,171.92 resulting in the following breakout for the 2016 bill:

Avon City \$33,653.34 (34.28%)

Avon Twp. \$40,859.15 (41.62%)

Collegeville Twp. \$23,659.43 (24.10%)

It was noted that \$5,000 was spent for first responder training. Wages reached a total of \$51,175.74 and have also been budgeted at \$50,000 in 2015. A proposal to buy new uniforms, shirts and pants is expected to cost about \$5,000. The 2015 "Uniform line item" is \$9,000. The total 2015 budget is an increase of \$13,828.08 from 2014. The jurisdiction billing detail was reviewed along with the depreciation schedule.

New member pay (first year) rate was discussed. It is currently \$8.00 per hour. This pay rate could be a deterrent to attracting new members and it is below minimum wage.

Motion by Bresnahan to increase the first year hourly pay rate to \$10.00.

Second-by-Simmon.

Motion passed unanimously.

Bob Simmon asked to have the Relief Association report presented to the Townships by January 1, 2016. Richard Bresnahan discussed the Norway Road work to be done in the summer of 2015. Lilac Road was also reported as very challenging for larger fire trucks and equipment. The legislature recently passed a law requiring newly constructed homes larger than 4,500 sq. ft. to have a sprinkler system.

Motion by Simmon to adjourn the meeting at 8:37 p.m. Second by Bresnahan Motion passed unanimously
